Congratulations to the 58 children who graduated from Children's University at Hope University on Monday 17th June. We had a lovely afternoon and were very proud of all of our graduates.

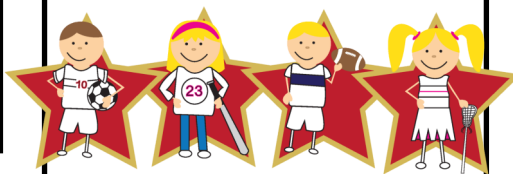
