Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct PE kit on the days that they are having PE in school. Our PE kit is:

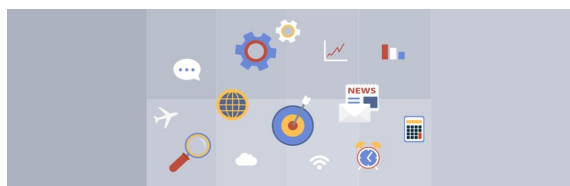
