



<p><u>Communication and Language</u></p> <p>We will learn new vocabulary relating to topic (travel and holidays) We will talk about places we have visited close to home and further away We will learn new songs and rhymes relating to our theme. We will engage in pretend play and talk to our peers in role. We will describe story settings, characters and retell story events.</p>	<p><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u></p> <p>We will be encouraged communicate with our friends whilst playing and respond to their ideas and suggestions We will be encouraged to talk freely about our home, holidays and community. We will learn about empathy and showing comfort to others if they are sad or upset. We will be encourages to share our ideas, interests and opinions. We will continue to learn about the behavioural expectations in class and whilst moving around school We will learn about going to Reception Class and complete transition activities (meet our new teachers, class, play areas. Visit communal places around school: hall, canteen etc)</p>	<p><u>Physical Development</u></p> <p>We will be encouraged to draw lines and circles and copy mark making patterns through gross motor movements (e.g. Squiggle time). We will continue to practise and develop our running, skipping, hopping, jumping and balancing and throwing and catching skills. We will continue to develop our pencil grip and control through fine motor skills activities. We will compete in running races and obstacle courses in preparation for sports day.</p>	<p>Nursery Class 2022/2023</p>  <p>Summer 2</p>
<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>We will continue to give meanings to the marks we make and begin to draw specific objects, giving some detail. We continue to learn letter sounds through the Read, Write Inc phonics programme as well as segmenting and blending sounds for reading and writing We will learn about syllables and clap the beats in our names and other words We will learn about rhyming words and make rhyming pairs We will learn letters in our name and trace, copy and write our names. We will write for purpose in role play areas, e.g. travel agents We will think about what different characters might be saying in stories and add speech bubbles to texts.</p>	<p>Nursery</p> 		<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>We will learn and regularly sing number songs We will learn about number composition: different numbers that make up 3, 4 and 5. We will count how many are in a set up to 5. We will learn different representations to identify numerals 1-5. We will order numerals 1-5 We will learn what comes before/ after a number? We will learn about jumping along a number line to find out what comes before/after a number. We will count along a number track and fill in missing numbers. We will sequence numerals 1-5</p>
