



# Year 1

## Autumn 1

### English

#### Cave Baby

Children will use the text to support them to write sentences by saying them out loud first. Children will act out parts of the story and use this to help them write their own simple narrative. The children will begin to read their writing to check it makes sense.

The children will have daily phonics lessons to support in writing and reading. In addition to the child will read with an adult weekly to develop skills such as fluency, pace and comprehension.

### French

Children will learn simple greetings, such as introducing themselves. The children will learn numbers to 10 in French.

### Computing

Children will be taught the different ways of being online and learn how to be safe while on them.

### Science

#### Living, dead and never alive

The children will learn about the differences between things that are alive, dead and things that have never lived. Children will complete scientific enquiries to test the information they have learnt and explore the four seasons and how these change around school.

### Physical Education

Children will begin by learning simple gymnastics actions and shapes. They will learn to apply basic strength to gymnastic actions and carry apparatus.

### Religious Education and World Views

Children will learn about differences and similarities and gain a deeper understanding and sense of belonging. The children will look at the religion of Hinduism. They will learn about Raksha Bandhan, design Rakhi bracelets and much more. We will also look at who the disciples were to Jesus.

### Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education

Children will learn that families have different people, look at what different emotions look like and understand that their actions can affect others.
