English

Lost and Sound

Children will have the opportunity to write a sequence of instructions using consistent tense, detailed diagrams and numbers or words indicating chronological order.

Yeti and the hird

The children will work on writing a complete story about two seemingly different characters, in the third person using past tense and using but and and as conjunctions.

Mathematics

Place Value within 10 (within 100 Y2)

- Sort, count and represent objects.
- Count forwards and backwards.
- Count one more and one less.
- Count using one to one correspondence.
- Compare objects and numbers.
- Ordinal numbers
- The number line.

Addition and Subtraction within 10. (Within 100 Y2)

- Part whole models.
- The addition Symbol.
- Addition facts
- Number bonds within 10. (Y2 within 100)

French

The children will learn how to greet people, say their name and take part in a simple question. We will revisit counting our numbers I - IO. Finally we will learn a rhyme about the tooth fairy in French.

Physical Education

During this term the children will be learning about gymnastics. This will help to develop balance, agility and they will learn more movements.

Science

Sea.s.an.s.

We will explore the season of Autumn and how it changes our environment and weather. We will collect data to use to compare future seasons.

Living things and their habitats. We will explore living and dead habitats looking closely at mini beasts in our own bug hotel. We will also look at food chains and collect information in order to compare habitats in autumn to habitats in summer.

Computing

Pupils will learn about changes to communication over the last few decades to a form that is now instant.

Music

All the learning is focused around one song: Hands, Feet, Heart. The children will be learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song.

Art and Design

Using storybook illustrations as a stimulus, children develop their mark-making to explore a wider range of tools and experiment with creating texture to add details to drawings.

Geography

During the first term the children will develop their geographical knowledge and skills. We will study Huyton through looking at and creating maps, in particular sketch maps and explore our local area by completing field work. Finally we will learn about compass points and how to use them accurately.

Religious Education and World Views

In Religious Education and World Views we will be looking at family and friends. We will look at the term belonging and what it means to the children. We will explore Hinduism and their values of family and friends and experience the culture of Hinduism and compare it to our own.

PSHE

Children will learn that different families are made up of different people. Consider what friends may be thinking and feeling in different situations, recognise some issues that may occur in friendships, and they may need an adult to help resolve. Explore what a gender stereotype is.

Reading and Phonics

Children will have daily phonics lessons looking closely at sounds and how to read and write these in words. Children will have three opportunities to read with an adult a week, two guided reads and one individual read. This will help to develop fluency
