During this term the children will be learning about yoga. They will learn the importance of stretching and exercise while being respectful to others.


<u>Science</u>

Computing

This activity will explore what friendship means online. The children will learn about the do's and don'ts of communicating over the internet.

Music

Our music lessons this term will focus on our Nativity performance at the end of term.

<u>Design Technology</u>

This term the children will be exploring stability and strengthening materials. Then will then make a chair for baby bear and test to see its suitability.

<u>History</u>

Children will look at their own personal history and then we will learn about the significance of Remembrance and why we remember. We will look closely at the significant individual Walter Tull and how his life was important during the time of the war and today.

Religious Education and World Views

In Religious Education and World View we will be looking at the celebration of Hanukkah. We will learn why it is celebrated, how it is celebrated and important symbols during this celebration. We will then begin to look at Christmas and why it is important to Christians.

<u>PSHE</u>

Health and Wellbeing The children will learn about the benefits of exercise and relaxation on physical health and wellbeing; strategies to manage different emotions, setting goals and developing a growth mindset and understanding dental hygiene.

Reading and Phonics

Children will have daily phonics lessons looking closely at sounds and how to read and write these in words. Children will have three opportunities to read with an adult a week, two guided reads and one individual read. This will help to develop fluency
