The Magic Bed

The children read some stories where fantasy worlds are represented, for example imaginary lands, space, animal homes. The children will plan a story where they are the main character now and that this is their fantastical adventure.

The Goldilocks Project

children use three different versions of Goldilocks for three different, but connected writing outcomes. children write a sequel to the original story, where Goldilocks and the bears meet many years later

Mathematics

Addition and Subtraction within 100. (Within 10 Y1)

French

The children will continue to greet people, say their name and take part in a simple question. Children will learn the mini-beasts through stories and songs. We will also recall colours and numbers.

Physical Education

Hockey- The unit builds on previous skills of sending and receiving a ball and moves on to developing tactics for game play.

Science

Seasons

We will explore the season of Spring and how it changes our environment and weather. We will collect data to use to compare future seasons.

Animals including humans

Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air). *Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

Computing

Using Scratch Jr the children will create a simple game. They will create sprites and learn the basics of using visual coding using Scratch Jr. The activity will introduce new concepts such as conditional language, repeat loops and debugging.

Music

Musical Me- children will develop their understanding of pitch.

Art and Design

The children will explore colour mixing for secondary colours and shades. They will use different tools and media to print and make patterns. They will explore the artist, Clarice Cliff.

History

The Great Fire of London

The children will learn about the significance of the Great Fire of London. We will look closely at the significant individual Samuel Pepys and how his diary was important during the time of the fire and today.

Religious Education and World Views

In Religious Education and World Views we will be looking at Baptism. The children will learn that Baptism is when someone becomes part of the Christian faith. They will recognise the symbols of Baptism. The children will also learn that Christians celebrate Easter.

PSHE

Continuing-Safety and the changing body

They will be introduced to the name of all body parts and learn the PANTS rule. The children will be taught how to keep safe near roads and understand why we take medicines.

Citizenship

Children will be able to explain why rules are in place. They will be able to identify positives and negatives about the school environment and also recognise the importance of looking after the school.

Reading and Phonics

Children will have daily phonics lessons looking closely at sounds and how to read and write these in words. Children are now in set phonics and reading groups daily.
