Mathematics

Shape

- Count money (pounds and pence)

Multiplication and division

French

The children will learn how to greet people, say their name and take part in a simple question. We will revisit counting our numbers 1 - 10. Finally, we will learn the months and learn to say 'Happy Birthday'

Physical Education

Dance- to perform dances using simple movement patterns. They will to reflect on different styles of dance, influenced by different cultures.

Science

Seasons

We will explore the season of Winter and how it changes our environment and weather. We will collect data to use to compare future seasons.

Animals including humans

Animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. In humans and some animals, these offspring will be young, such as babies or kittens, that grow into adults. In other animals, such as chickens or insects, there may be eggs laid that hatch to young or other stages which then grow to adults.

Computing

The children will learn to use presentation software and develop their keyboard skills in order to present their ideas

Music

Orchestral instruments (Theme: Traditional stories)

Design Technology

This term the children will be exploring stability and strengthening materials. Then will then make a chair for baby bear and test to see its suitability.

Geography

During this term the children will develop their geographical knowledge and skills. We will study The UK through looking at features of each country, learning about the capital cities and being able to locate each country on a map. We will also learn about the surrounding seas of the UK.

Religious Education and World Views

In Religious Education and World Views we will be looking at Hinduism. The children will learn the story of Rama and Sita, the celebration of Diwali and daily puja. The children will learn to be respectful and tolerant to other faiths and learn the basic Hindu beliefs.

PSHE

Safety and the changing body

The children will learn how the internet can be used to help us and how to be safe online. They will be introduced to the name of all body parts and learn the PANTS rule. The children will be taught how to keep safe near roads and understand why we take medicines.

Reading and Phonics

Children will have daily phonics lessons looking closely at sounds and how to read and write these in words. Children will have three opportunities to read with an adult a week, two guided reads and one individual read. This will help to develop fluency
